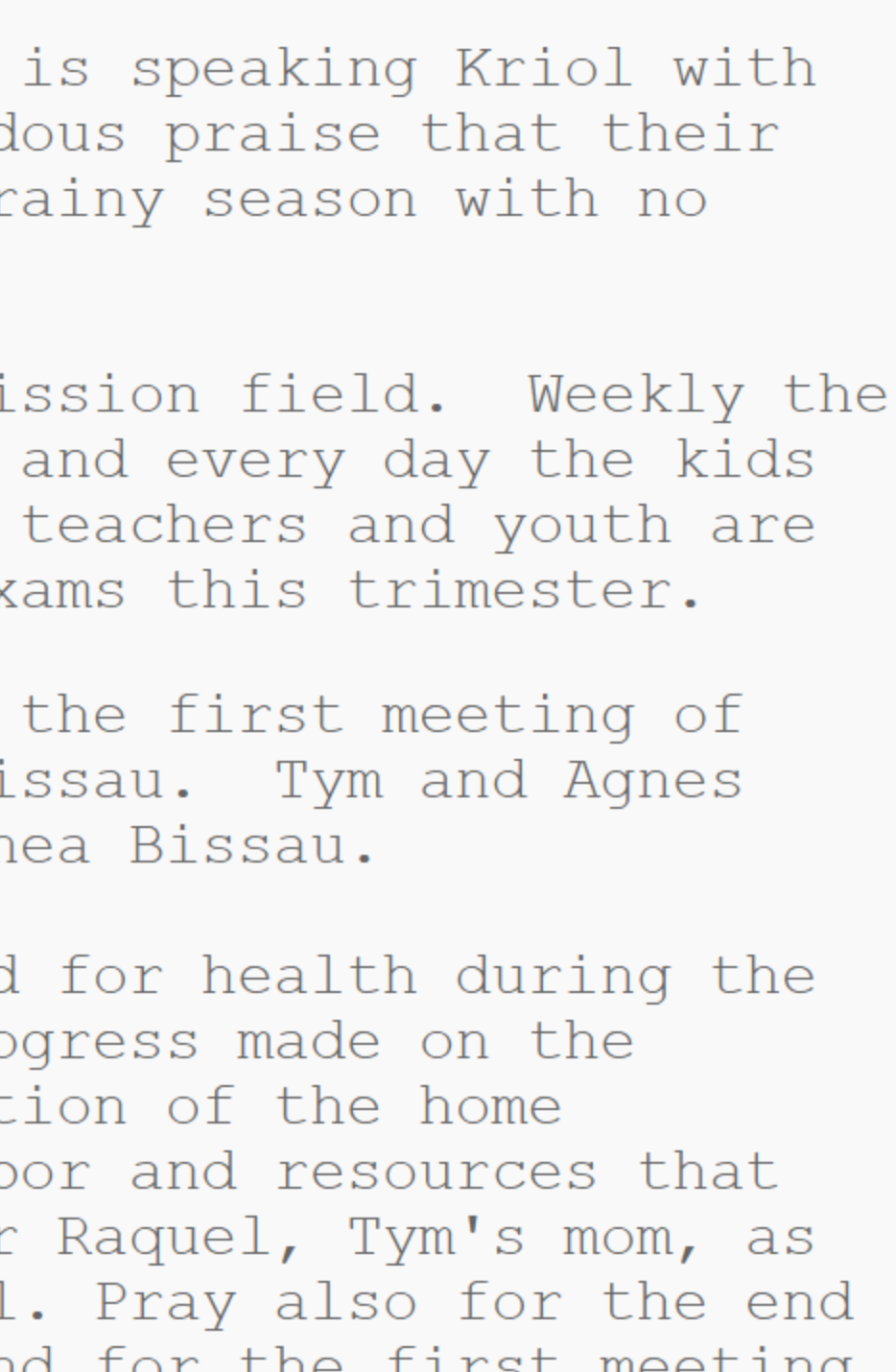
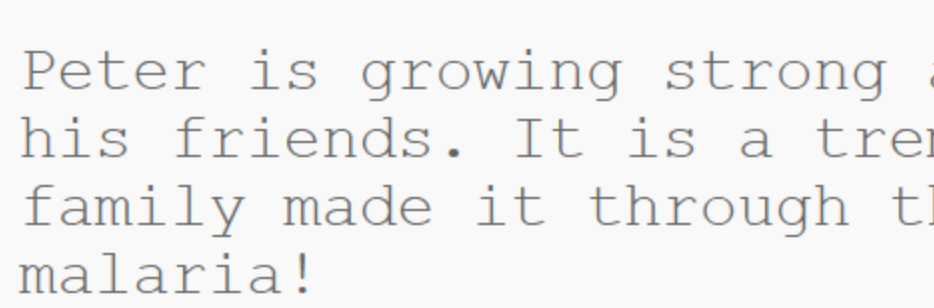
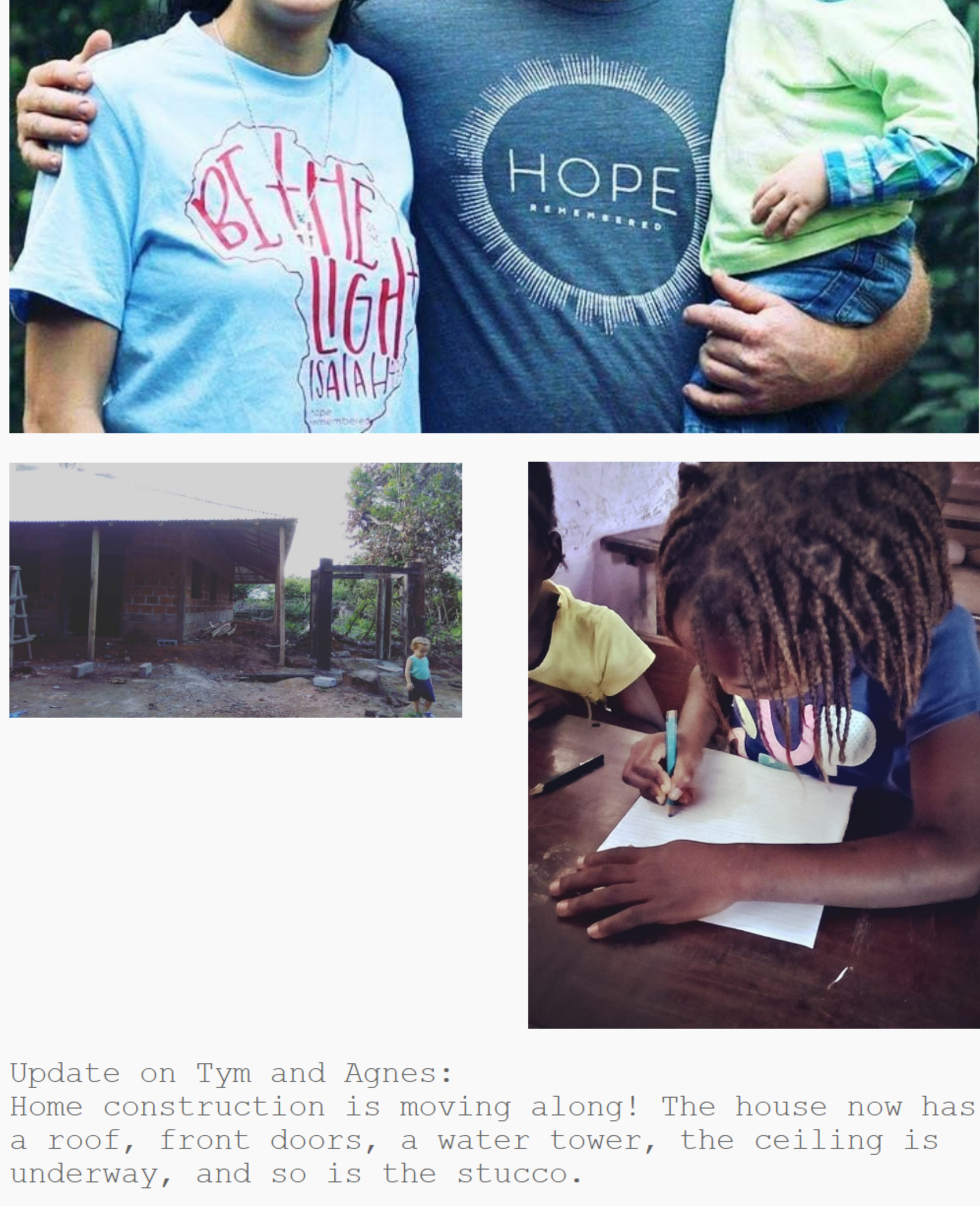
THE Joy OF CHRISTMAS IS Jesus

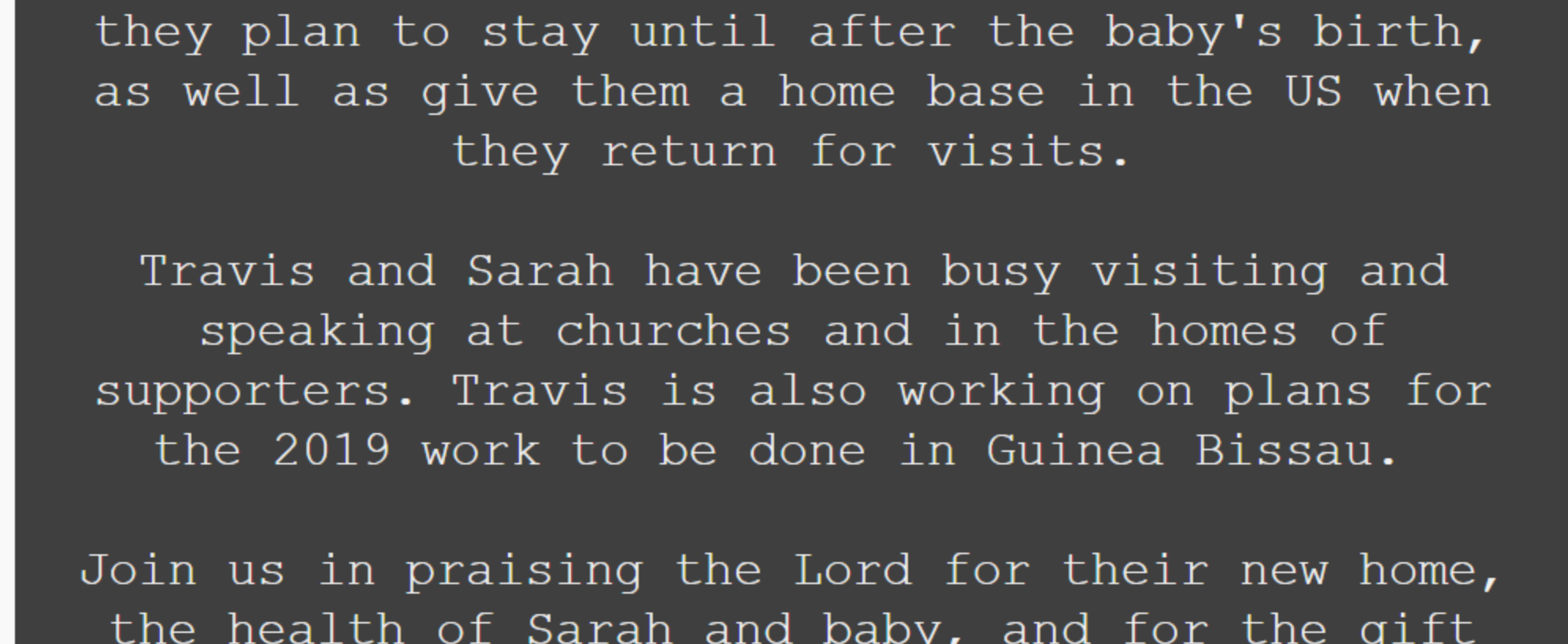
Update on Tym and Agnes: Home construction is moving along! The house now has a roof, front doors, a water tower, the ceiling is underway, and so is the stucco.

The school is their daily mission field. Weekly the children hear Bible stories and every day the kids have a time of prayer. The teachers and youth are preparing for their final exams this trimester.

This month they are hosting the first meeting of missionary kids in Guinea Bissau. Tym and Agnes both grew up as MK's in Guinea Bissau.

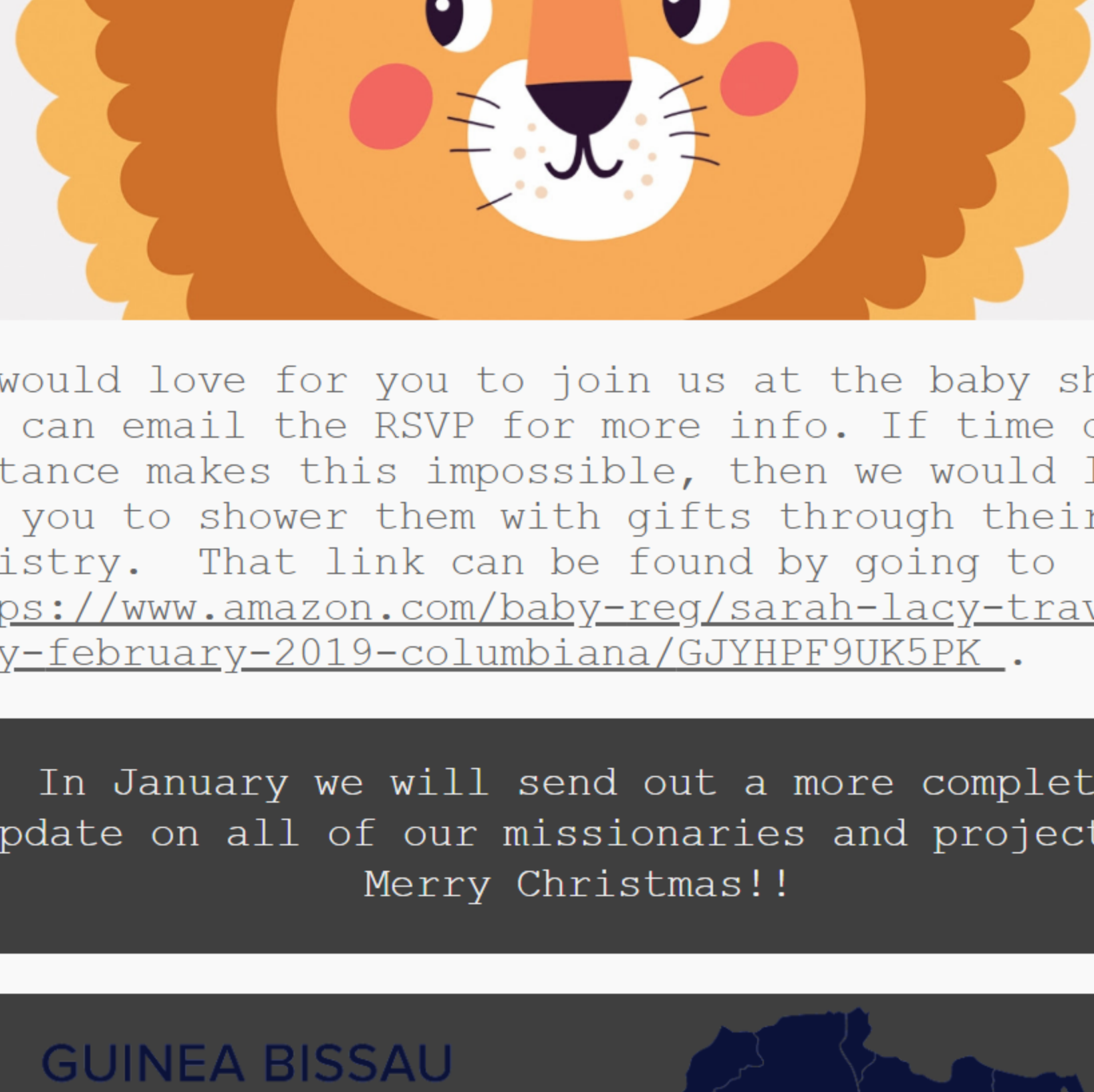

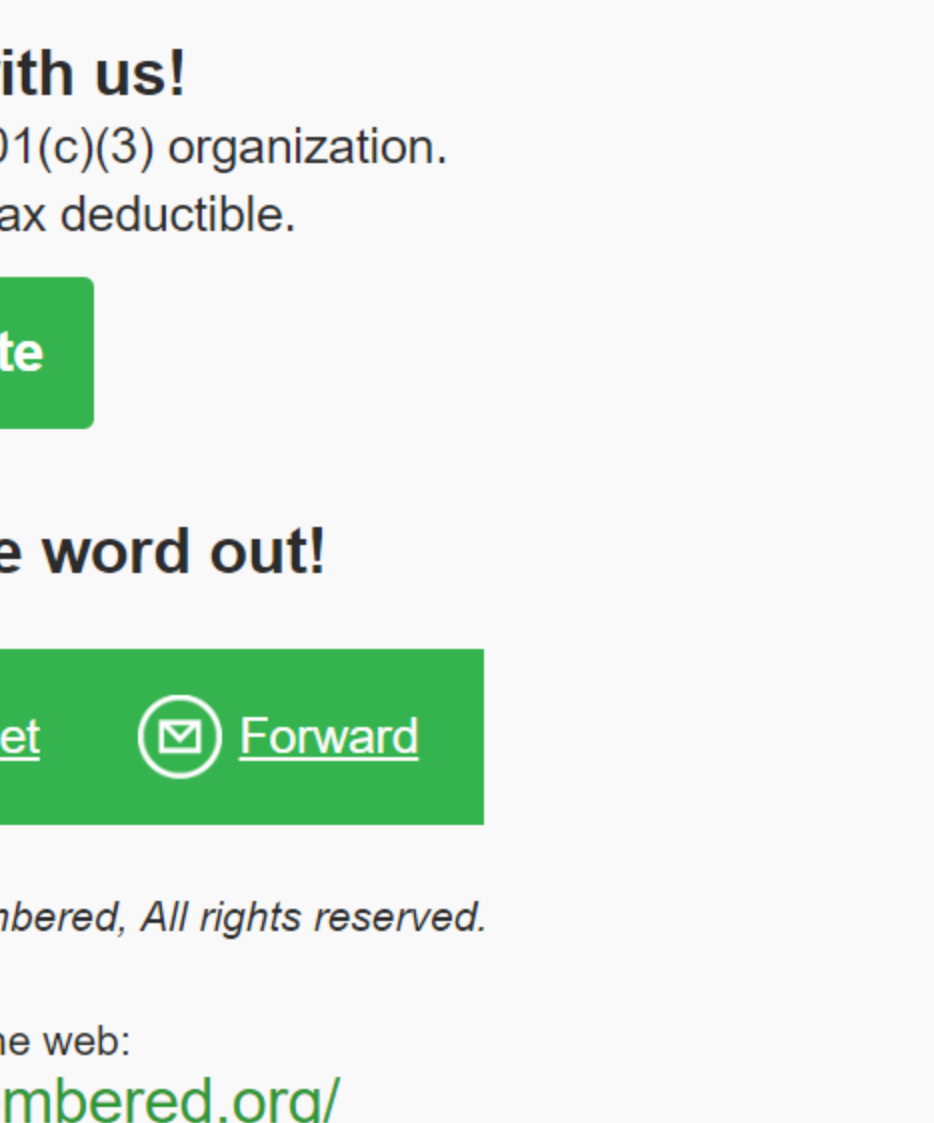
