

## Transforming West Africa with the Hope of Christ







We hope to do some traveling later this spring to meet with partners and update them in person about the work in Guinea-Bissau. In April Travis is planning to attend a training at Equip International focusing on



how to select, build, and repair different types of water pumps. He hopes to learn how to build and repair simple water pumps with affordable materials that are readily available in Guinea Bissau. Most people have open wells and use buckets to draw the water. This causes a lot of contamination that could easily be avoided by closing the well and installing a simple pump. We hope to be able to incorporate these skills into our agriculture training so that people can be trained to build these pumps in their own villages.
