

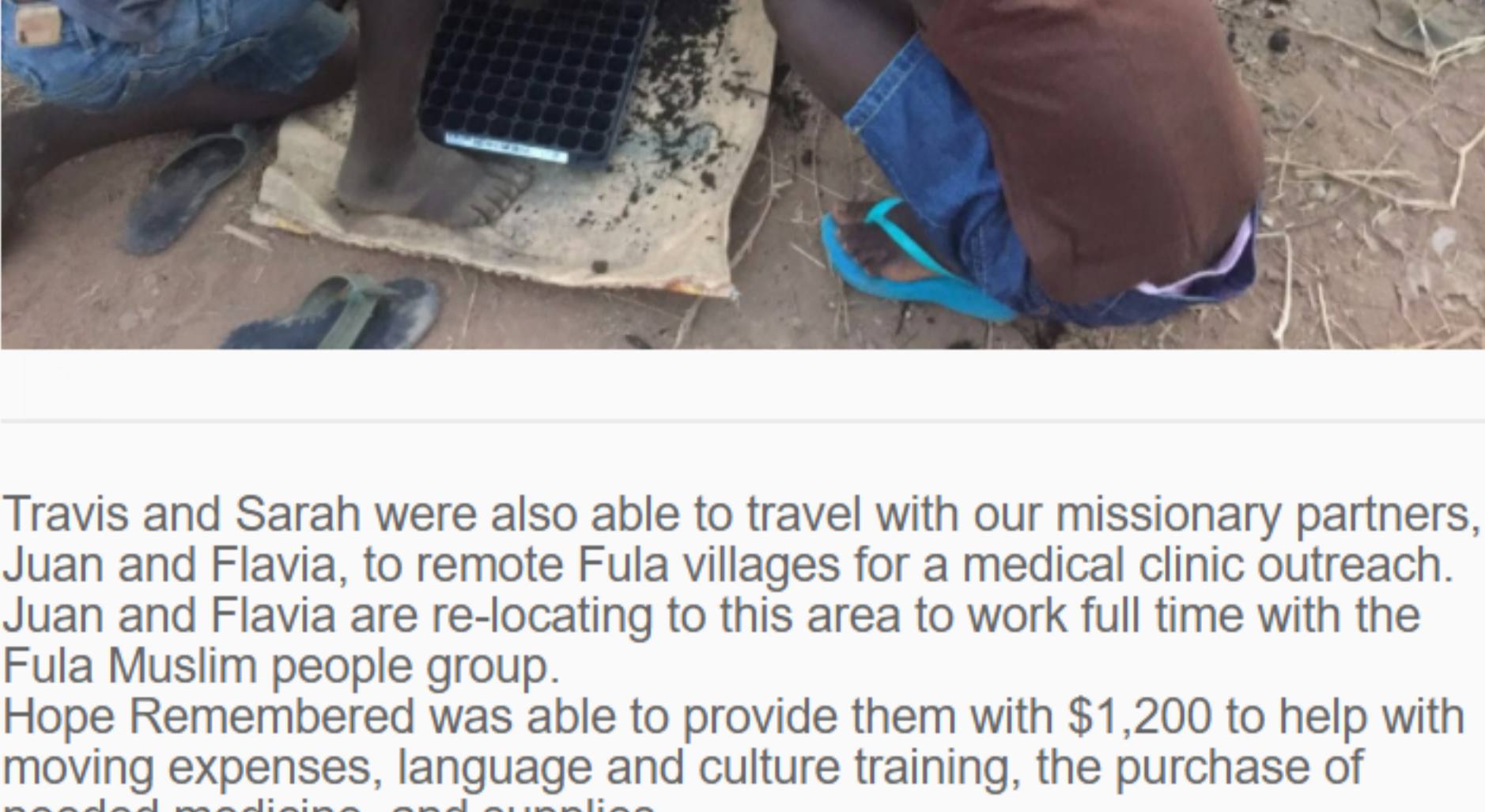
# hope remembered

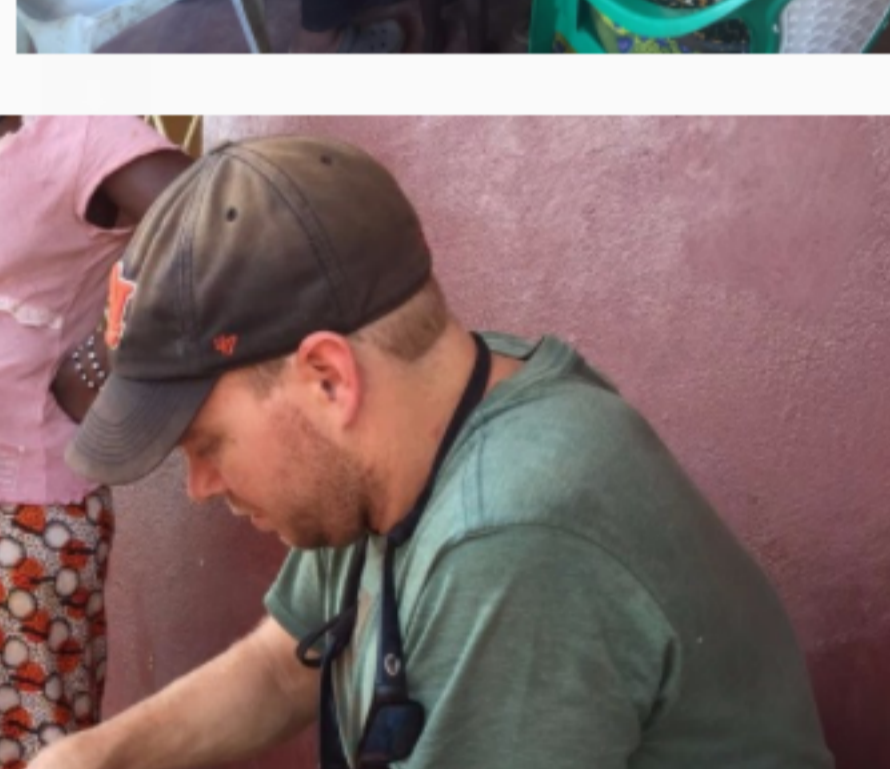
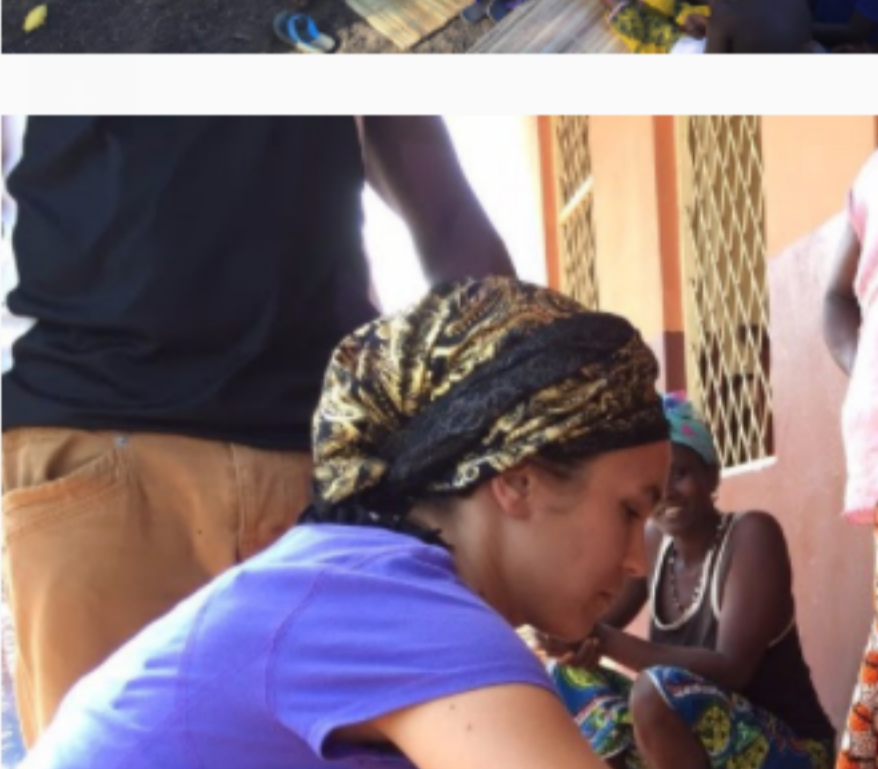

Travis has been in Guinea Bissau a month now and quickly began work on the new farming techniques. Drip irrigation was successfully installed at Fredy and Raquel's farm in Quebo. Travis will continue training and perfecting techniques as they prepare for the agricultural training center in the future. The boys on the farm have loved learning and working alongside Travis!



Travis and Sarah were also able to travel with our missionary partners, Juan and Flavia, to remote Fula villages for a medical clinic outreach. Juan and Flavia are re-locating to this area to work full time with the Fula Muslim people group. Hope Remembered was able to provide them with \$1,200 to help with moving expenses, language and culture training, the purchase of needed medicine, and supplies. Please pray for new Fula believers in this area. Missionaries are working to disciple these new believers and plant a church. Pray that as these medical clinics provide physical healing that the Lord would move to spread His Church among these people.



Sarah has been able to re-connect to former partners and friends during her three years working and living in Guinea Bissau through Wycliffe. Her fluency in the local main language has been a great help. Travis is continuing language study and is quickly growing in his ability to communicate. Below is a picture of Sarah sharing the story of Gideon from the Bible to a group of students. Sarah and Travis have also been able to worship with a local body of believers. The boys and girls in Quebo love taking a break from working and learning by playing at a local river. I think the adults enjoy it just as much!

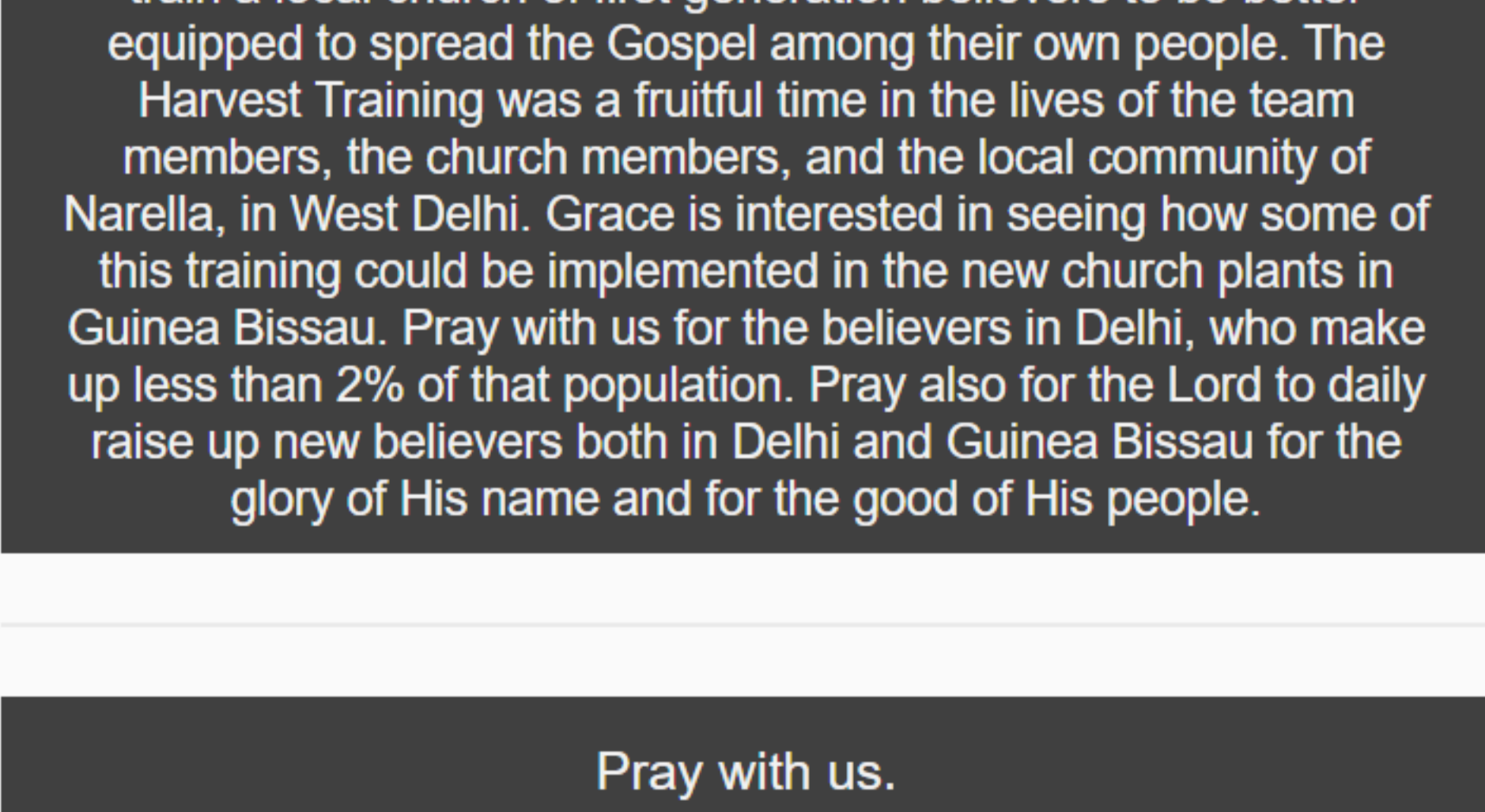
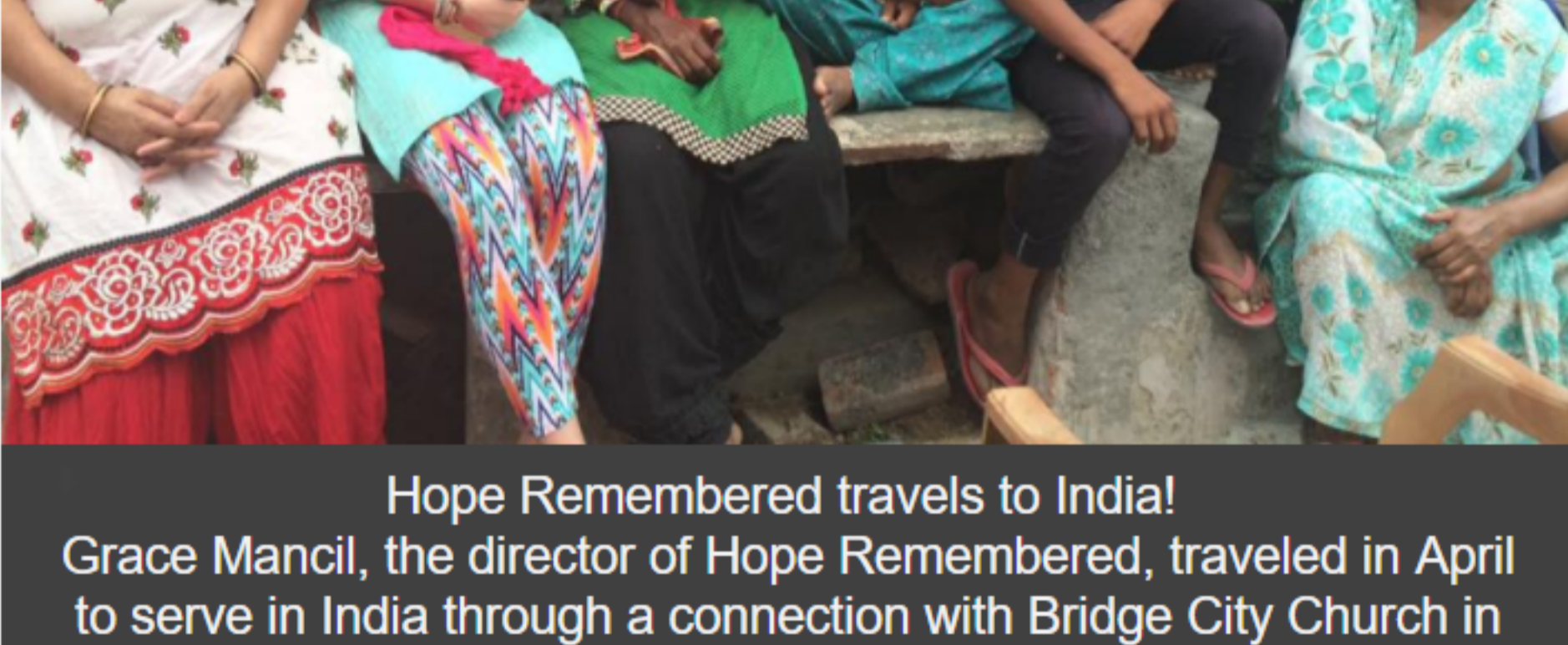

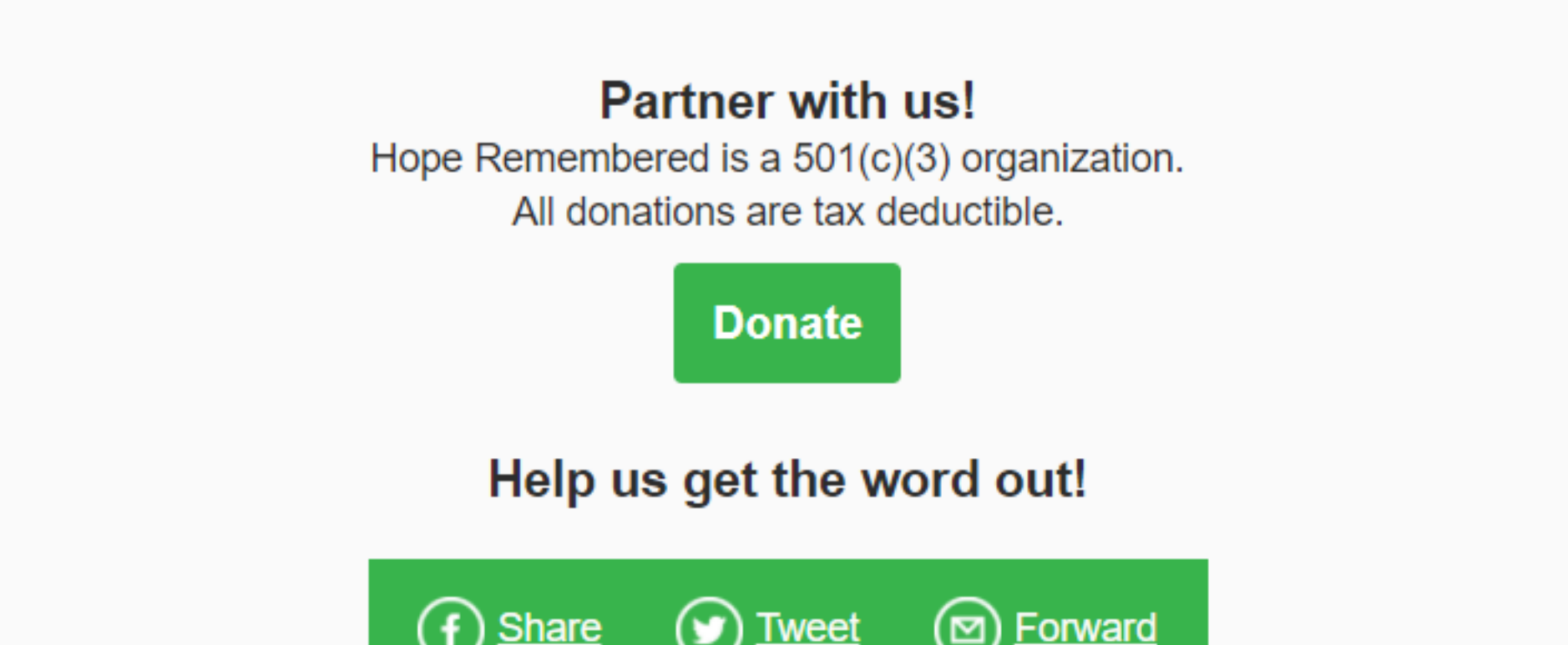
Hope Remembered was able to give \$1000 in the month of April to the work of Fredy and Raquel. We are truly thankful for this partnership and your generosity!
