Instead of registering for gifts for our wedding we asked people to donate money towards the building of our home in Guinea Bissau. The money will go towards construction costs of the home and well, installation of solar power, and furnishings. We estimated that the total would be around \$20,000. Through your generous gifts we are already at about 80% of having all that we will need to complete our home! 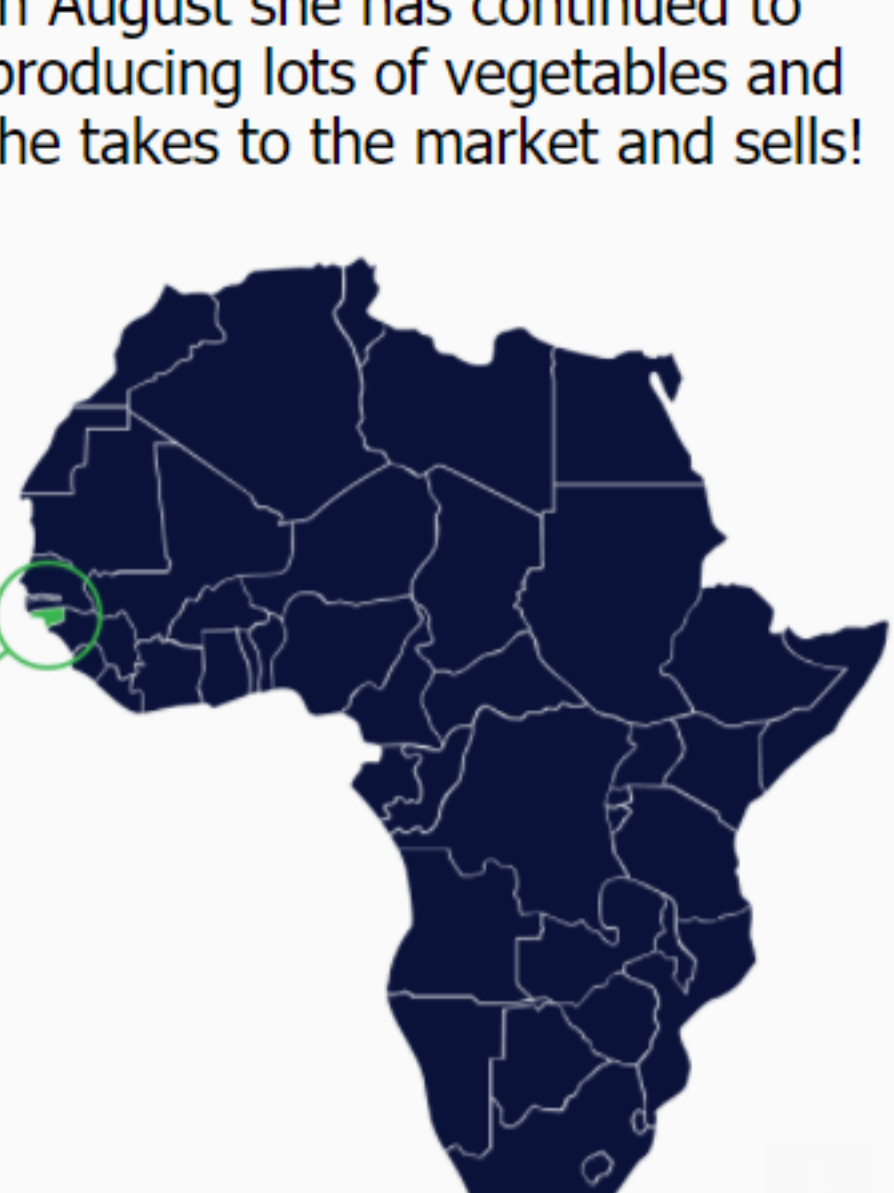

While we were in Guinea Bissau this summer we worked on a test garden using drip irrigation. The goal was to train some of the young people how to install and maintain a drip irrigation system and to see which vegetables we could grow in the dry season. This young woman was one of the main helpers and really caught on to what we were trying to do. Since we left in August she has continued to maintain the garden. It has been producing lots of vegetables and she has even had some extra that she takes to the market and sells!
